SU Contracts:

Barbara Burrington reminded the board that salaries have been set. However, the board needs to discuss the 1/1/18 insurance changes. Support staff overall compensation needs to be similar to all other non-union employees. Board action is required for benefit decisions. Gary Marckres made a motion to offer the same benefit package to Central Office support staff as the Grand Isle support staff will receive. Second by Dave Davis. All in favor.

Network Administrator Position:

Megan Grube advised that most people have seen the tech audit that was done. David Isham is retiring June 30, 2017. This is an opportunity for restructuring the Network Administrator position, and possibly adding an IT position. Network Administrator position could include such things as ordering, looking at different tech options, creating efficiencies, serving on the tech committee, etc. Some of these responsibilities would take some work off Megan Grube's plate. Barbara Burrington is looking at merging job descriptions from other districts to create a job description for GISU.

Megan Grube said that we need to decide on a job description and look at long term goals. She has asked David Isham to write down what he does and issues he takes care of. There have been discussions with Greg Smith (Net Source), and he seems interested in staying with our district.

The Executive Committee decided that the June 7, 2017 GISU meeting was not necessary and will be skipped.
