Dear Parents, Guardians & Community members,

This is a **TIME SENSITIVE ANNOUNCEMENT**

As frequent readers of the community weekly letter you know the Governor had added the following to his executive order: “Attendance at all public and private social, recreational and entertainment gatherings, indoor and outdoor, including large social gatherings incidental to ceremonies, holiday gatherings, parties and celebrations, shall be limited to participation with only members of a single household.” In fact you also know that my own had created a Pod with two other households and had planned to have a Thanksgiving dinner together; and that based on the adjusted order we have now shifted the plans to get together virtually. **At today’s Governor’s Press Conference the Governor announced that a question about combining households for gatherings will be added to the screening questions schools ask when we return from the break and that any families who have combined households will need to quarantine as if they had traveled out of state.** I apologize I do not have the specific language as it has not been posted as of noon today. I thought it was important that families have this information as soon as possible in case they need to make adjustments to their holiday plans.

I had not planned to hold a community meetin this week however with this new information I will change those plans and will hold a Community Meeting on November 25, 2020 to discuss this change and help with any questions parents and guardians may have.
