

ACT 166 CHECKLIST FOR PARENTS

Any family who has a preschool-age student attending a private preschool can get funding for 10 hours per week, up to 35 weeks. The exact legislation and pricing are available on the Agency of Education website.

HOW TO APPLY FOR PRE-QUALIFIED PRESCHOOL

When a family would like to apply for Act 166 they can get our registration paperwork and residency paperwork off the website. www.gisu.org > departments > student services > Act 166.

- Complete Form I Preschool Student Registration Form
- Complete Form II Application for Publicly Funded Preschool
- Complete the Residency Verification form for the town you reside in& send to GISU unless the following:
 - You completed residency verification last school year, or
 - You have a school-age child already enrolled in the district

If a family has already proven residency in a prior year or with a student already in our schools they will need to receive a voucher. The voucher can be found www.gisu.org > departments > student services > Act 166.

- Enroll your child into the daycare, and then send Tiffany Pezzimenti an email at TPezzimenti@gisu.org on where the child will be attending preschool.
