

II. APPLICATION FOR PUBLICLY FUNDED PRESCHOOL

Public funding for Preschool is for 10 hours a week for 35 weeks per year directly following the school calendar. In order to qualify for funding, your child must attend a Pre-Qualified Program for at least 10 hours a week.
