According to the [VT Department of Health there were 48 cases of COVID 19](#) in Vermont Schools last week. The GISU continues to do well with just three confirmed cases since last March and no confirmed cases of transmission in the schools. This is a result of the hard work of the Students, Faculty, Staff, Administration, Parents, and Community. I continue to be impressed with how everyone is working together to keep schools safe.
